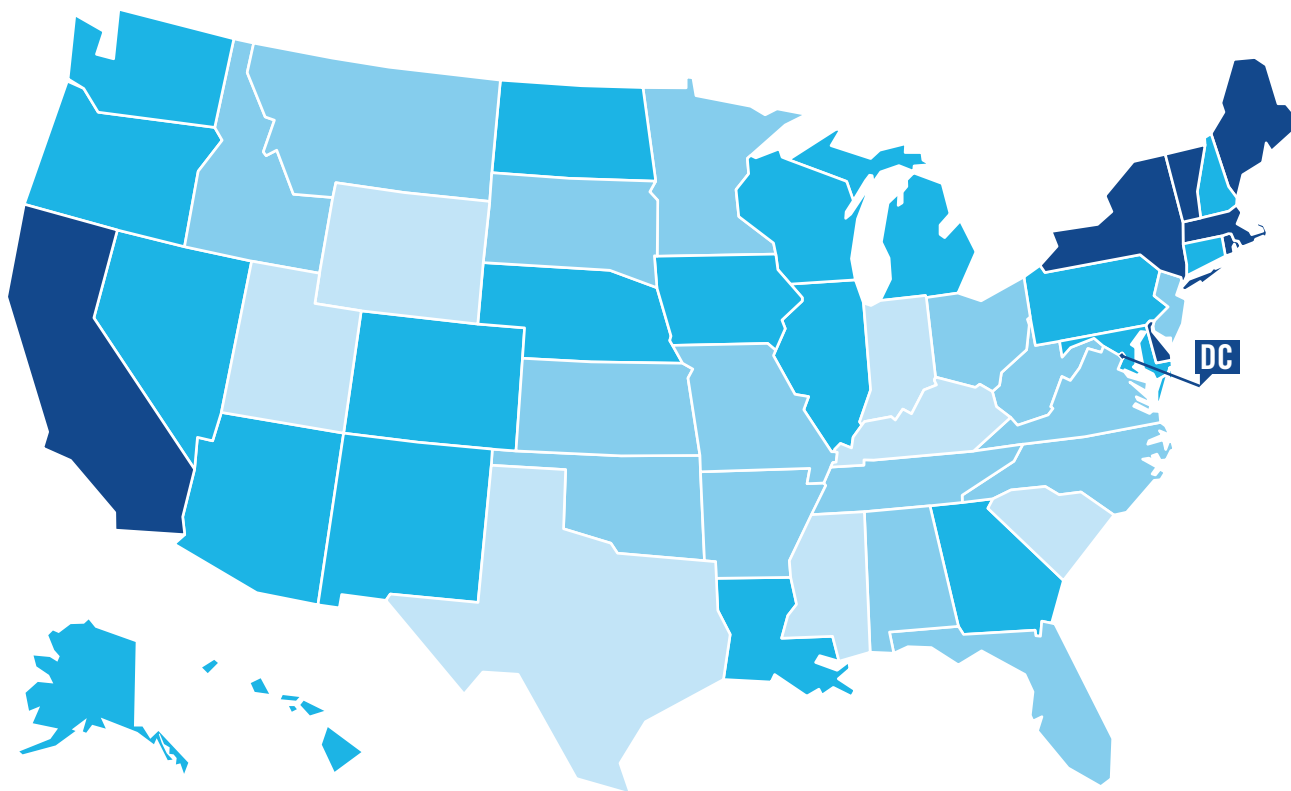

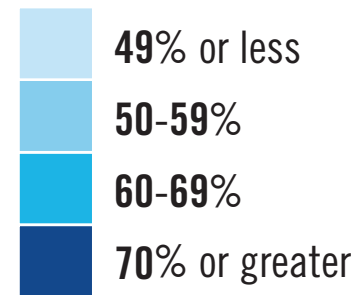
Percentage of adolescent boys and girls who have received one or more doses of HPV vaccine\*
