


## Kansas Influenza Surveillance 2020-2021

Influenza is not a nationally notifiable disease, nor is it a notifiable disease in Kansas; therefore, the burden of influenza is monitored through other surveillance methods.

## Kansas Flu by the Numbers 2019-2020 2020-2021 **Emergency Department Visits** 10.5% 1.9% Highest weekly percentage of visits due to influenza-like illness (ILI) reported by syndromic surveillance **Deaths** Four deaths were directly attributed to 141 6 influenza and two deaths had influenza documented as a contributing factor during the 2020-2021 season.

## Percentage of visits for ILI reported by ILINet Sites Oct. 2018-Sept. 2021



Low influenza-like illness during the 2020-2021 season may be attributed to the public health measures such as mask usage and social distancing put in place to prevent COVID-19 transmission.

The Kansas Health and Environmental Laboratories did not report any influenza positive specimens during the 2020-2021 season.
