

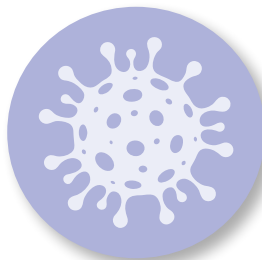


# COVID-19 Delta Variant

The new "Delta" COVID-19 variant is much more contagious than previous variants.



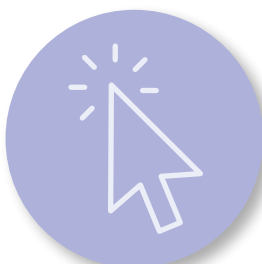
Delta is spreading most quickly in communities that have the lowest vaccination rates.
