KSWebIZ Introduction

- Rolled out in August 2005
- Birth to death online state immunization registry
- Repository for all routine immunizations
- 24,814,244 Vaccines
- 2,624,787 Patients
- 2,098 Participating Facilities

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Statutes & Administrative Rules

- Reporting to KSWebIZ is only mandated for pharmacies, per 65-1635a
- Per KDHE administrative rule, it is required that consent to share data with KSWebIZ be captured for each patient whose data is being shared
- If the data comes from the Health Information Exchange, consent to share data is not required, per 65-6825

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How is data submitted?

- HL7 Interface
 - Direct Connection to KSWebIZ
 - Connection through the Health Information Exchange
 - Kansas Health Information Network (KHIN)
 - Lewis and Clark Information Exchange (LACIE)
- Direct Entry/Manual Entry

Who can participate?

- Any agency that provides immunization services
 - At least 1 immunization per year
- Any agency that has access to immunization data and is authorized to share the immunization data

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Is there a cost to participate?

- There is no cost to participate with KSWebIZ

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Benefits of Participating

- Reporting functionality
- GIS capabilities
- Vaccine forecast and recommendations
- Prevent missed opportunities
- Complete patient immunization record in centralized location
- Access to electronic Pink Card and Kansas Certificate of Immunizations

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KSWebIZ Facts

- Supporting bi-directional HL7 since 2007
 - Average of 5,175 HL7 queries per day and 2,431 HL7 updates per day
 - Over 600 facilities submitting via HL7 interface
 - About 300 facilities testing HL7 interface connections
 - Over 50 EMR vendors supporting HL7 interface connections
- School module started in 2009 and has contributed over 1 million vaccine records
- 89% of schools submit data to KSWebIZ
- 96% opt in rate at birth via the birth certificate
