Increasing HPV Vaccination Rates

•"Someone You Love" had been used for community showings to adults

•During IKC subcommittee meetings we started brainstorming about showing it to 7th graders, close to the recommended age for the vaccine.

•The SCHD Health Promotions Coordinator knew the staff member in charge of Sex Education for Topeka School District #501.

•We met in January and discussed bring the video into the schools during their Sex Education Curriculum in April.



•The Midwest Cancer Alliance had used a pre/post test for their community showings.

•Midwest Cancer Alliance had IRB approval for their pre/post tests.

•With feedback from the IKC Education Subcommittee we developed the Pre/Post Test for 7th Graders.

•Submitted to the KDHE IRB for exemption from oversight. Exemption was granted with changes to the pre/post test.



Nuts and Bolts

- The Sex Education coordinator contacted the teacher in each building – 4 out of 6 responded.
- Three of the schools had block schedules, 90 minute classes. The Video is 80 minutes.
- One school had 45 minute classes, we had to show the video in two parts.



Nuts and Bolts

- 3x5 notecards and pencils were handed out to each student to write down questions.
- The Immunization Team Leader, an RN, answered the questions and sent them back to the teachers.



Pre and Post Test Results

Only used the tests from the 90 minute class periods.

• Total of 407 students.



Pre Test

- Heard of HPV? Yes 34% , No 66%
 - If yes where? Most said parents or doctor. A few mentioned TV ads.
- HPV can cause cancer in:
 - Neither 1%
 - Both 78%
 - Male 1%
 - Female 20%



Pre-Test

- Have you had the HPV vaccine:
- – Yes 22%
 - No 23%
 - Not Sure 55%
- Do you want to get the vaccine:
 - Yes 63%
 - No 33%
 - Not sure 4%



Post Test

- HPV can cause cancer in: (very little change)
 - Neither < 1%
 - Both 83%
 - Male <1%
 - Female 16%
- Would you choose the vaccine for yourself:
 - Yes 87%
 - No 13%
 - Most common reason for yes was so "I won't get cancer"
 - Reason for No "just a child" "don't need it yet" "scared"



Common Questions Asked by Students

- What is HPV, how do you get it, at what age can you get it.
- Several questions about race and ethnicity
- Several questions about cancer and treatment
- Questions about some of the procedures in the video, the pap test, hysterectomy, etc.



Lessons Learned (or would I do it again?)

- Pre and post test had fairly different questions, it is hard to compare knowledge before and after the video.
- It did not work to show the video in 2 parts.
- One staff member had to sit through the video 12 times!
- Having them write out the questions gave us some great information!
