 - o Recommending vaccination (the presumptive recommendation)
 - o Getting accurate information to parents & adult patients (includes giving the VIS)
 - o Building trust
 - o Building expectations for the next visit
- Bringing patients in (reminders, recall) especially after a disruption in services (e.g., pandemic, tornado)
- Ensuring high quality vaccine delivery for patients in the office
 - o Follow the recommended immunization schedule
 - Screen for contraindications
 - Administer the vaccine using best practices
 - o Don't miss an opportunity
 - Standing orders
 - Prompting providers
 - o Document in EHR (or chart) and KSWebIZ

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
