

Immunize Kansas Coalition Highlights New Updates to Respiratory Season Resources and More!

In June, the CDC updated their recommendations for RSV vaccination to adults over 75 and for adults aged 60-74 at higher risk of severe RSV.

As the season kicks off and to reflect these changes, the Immunize Kansas Coalition (IKC) has updated key resources for partners to utilize in their outreach efforts this fall and winter.

These include the coalition's:

The most recent update to the insert includes adding the RSV vaccine as an additional vaccine for older adults.
